(MORNING)

29 November (Day 1): ♦ **Thunderstorm** accompanied with **lightning** very likely at isolated places over Coastal Andhra Pradesh & Yanam, Rayalaseema, Kerala & Mahe and Tamilnadu, Puducherry & Karaikal.

♦ **Dense fog** very likely in isolated pockets over south Assam & Meghalaya and Odisha during morning hours.

♦ **Heavy to very rainfall** very likely at isolated places over Tamilnadu, Puducherry & Karaikal and **heavy rainfall** at isolated places over Coastal Andhra Pradesh & Yanam.

♦ **Squally weather** conditions likely to prevails over southwest Arabian Sea and southwest Bay of Bengal off Sri Lanka coast.

30 November (Day 2): ♦ **Thunderstorm** accompanied with **lightning** very likely at isolated places over Coastal Andhra Pradesh & Yanam, Rayalaseema, Kerala & Mahe, Lakshadweep and Tamilnadu, Puducherry & Karaikal.

♦ **Heavy rainfall** at a few places with **very heavy falls** at isolated places very likely over Tamilnadu, Puducherry & Karaikal and **heavy rainfall** at isolated places over Coastal Andhra Pradesh & Yanam, Rayalaseema and Kerala & Mahe.

01 December (Day 3): ♦ **Thunderstorm** accompanied with **lightning** very likely at isolated places over Coastal Andhra Pradesh & Yanam, Rayalaseema, South Interior Karnataka, Kerala & Mahe, Lakshadweep and Tamilnadu, Puducherry & Karaikal.

♦ **Heavy rainfall** at a few places with **very heavy falls** at isolated places very likely over Tamilnadu, Puducherry & Karaikal; **heavy to very heavy rainfall** at isolated places over Kerala & Mahe and **heavy rainfall** at isolated places over Coastal Andhra Pradesh & Yanam, Rayalaseema and South Interior Karnataka.

02 December (Day 4): ♦ **Thunderstorm** accompanied with **lightning** likely at isolated places over South Interior Karnataka, Kerala & Mahe, Lakshadweep and Tamilnadu, Puducherry & Karaikal.

♦ **Heavy rainfall** likely at isolated places over Tamilnadu, Puducherry & Karaikal and Kerala & Mahe.

03 December (Day 5): ♦ **Thunderstorm** accompanied with **lightning** likely at isolated places over South Interior Karnataka, Kerala & Mahe, Lakshadweep and Tamilnadu, Puducherry & Karaikal.

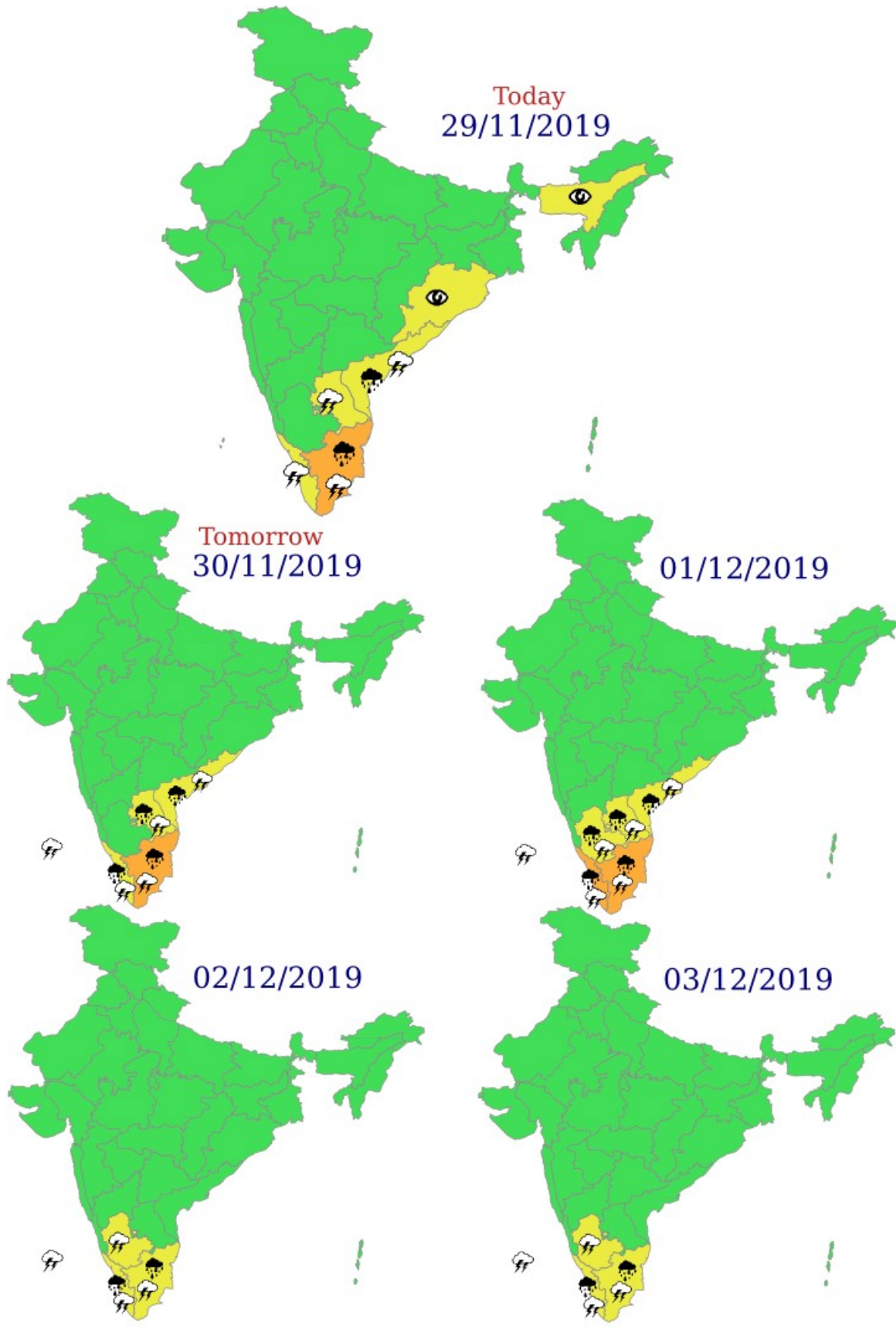
♦ **Heavy rainfall** likely at isolated places over Tamilnadu, Puducherry & Karaikal and Kerala & Mahe.

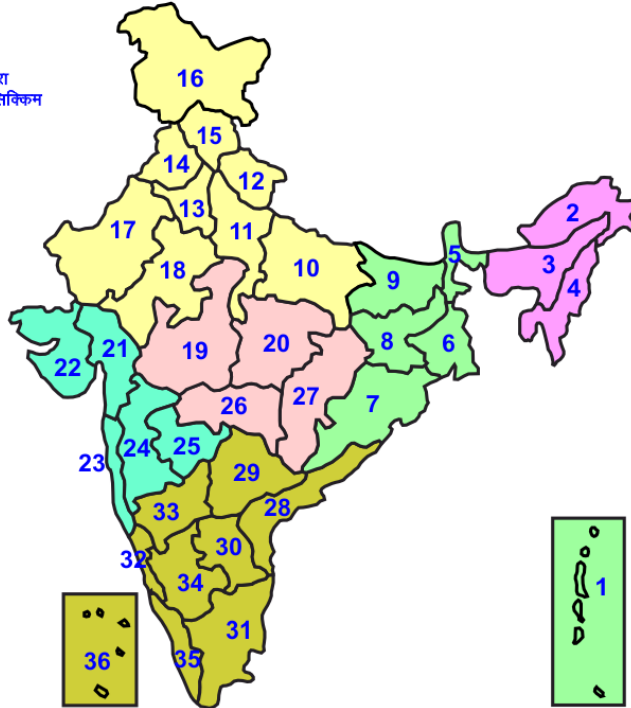
