



All India Weather Warning Bulletin

Tuesday 29 October 2019
Time of Issue: 1315 hours IST

(MID-DAY)

29 October (Day 1): ♦ Heavy to very heavy rainfall very likely at isolated places over Tamilnadu, Puducherry & Karaikal, Kerala & Mahe and Lakshadweep and **Heavy rainfall** at isolated places over Telangana and Rayalseema.

♦ **Thunderstorm accompanied with lightning** very likely at isolated places over West Madhya Pradesh, Vidarbha, Madhya Maharashtra, Marathwada, Coastal Andhra Pradesh & Yanam, Telangana, Rayalseema, Karnataka, Tamilnadu, Puducherry & Karaikal, Kerala & Mahe and Lakshadweep.

♦ **Squally winds**, speed reaching 40-50 kmph gusting to 60 kmph, very likely over Comorin Area and adjoining equatorial Indian Ocean and Maldives area and speed reaching 30-40 kmph gusting to 50 kmph over south Tamilnadu coast, Gulf of Mannar and adjoining southwest Bay of Bengal. **Gale winds**, speed reaching 200-210 kmph gusting to 230 kmph, very likely over westcentral and adjoining eastcentral & north Arabian Sea.

♦ **Sea condition** is very likely to **phenomenal** over westcentral and adjoining eastcentral & north Arabian Sea and **rough to very rough** over Comorin area & adjoining Equatorial Indian Ocean and Maldives area. Fishermen are advised not to venture into these areas.

30 October (Day 2): ♦ Heavy to very heavy rainfall with extremely heavy falls very likely at isolated places over Lakshadweep; **heavy to very heavy rainfall** very likely at isolated places over Tamilnadu, Puducherry & Karaikal and Kerala & Mahe and **Heavy rainfall** at isolated places over Coastal Andhra Pradesh & Yanam, Telangana and Coastal & South Interior Karnataka.

♦ **Thunderstorm accompanied with lightning** very likely at isolated places over West Madhya Pradesh, Vidarbha, Madhya Maharashtra, Marathwada, Konkan & Goa, Coastal Andhra Pradesh & Yanam, Telangana, Rayalseema, Karnataka, Tamilnadu, Puducherry & Karaikal, Kerala & Mahe and Lakshadweep.

♦ **Squally winds**, speed reaching 45-55 kmph gusting to 65 kmph, likely over Lakshadweep-Maldives areas and adjoining southeast Arabian Sea and along & off Kerala coast. **Gale winds**, speed reaching 140-150 kmph gusting to 170 kmph, very likely over westcentral and adjoining eastcentral & north Arabian Sea.

♦ **Sea condition** is very likely to **phenomenal** over westcentral and adjoining eastcentral & north Arabian Sea and **rough to very rough** over southeast Arabian Sea & adjoining Lakshadweep-Maldives areas and along & off Kerala and south Karnataka coasts. 31 October (Day 3): ♦ Heavy to very heavy rainfall with extremely heavy falls very likely at isolated places over Lakshadweep; **heavy to very heavy rainfall** very likely at isolated places over Kerala & Mahe and **Heavy rainfall** at isolated places over Coastal & South Interior Karnataka.

♦ **Thunderstorm accompanied with lightning** very likely at isolated places over Konkan & Goa, Marathwada and Madhya Maharashtra.

♦ **Squally winds**, speed reaching 50-60 kmph gusting to 70 kmph, likely over southeast Arabian Sea & adjoining Lakshadweep-Maldives areas and Squally winds speed reaching 45-55 kmph gusting to 65 kmph along & off Kerala and south Karnataka coasts. **Gale winds**, speed reaching 120-130 kmph gusting to 140 kmph, likely over westcentral and adjoining eastcentral & north Arabian Sea.

♦ **Sea condition** is likely to **very rough to high** over westcentral and adjoining eastcentral & north Arabian Sea. and **rough to very rough** over southeast Arabian Sea & adjoining Lakshadweep-Maldives areas and along & off Kerala and south Karnataka coasts Fishermen are advised not to venture into these areas.

01 November (Day 4): ♦ Thunderstorm accompanied with lightning and hail likely at isolated places over Jammu & Kashmir.

♦ **Squally wind**, speed reaching 55-65 kmph gusting to 75 kmph, likely to prevail over eastcentral Arabian Sea. Fishermen are advised not to venture into these areas.

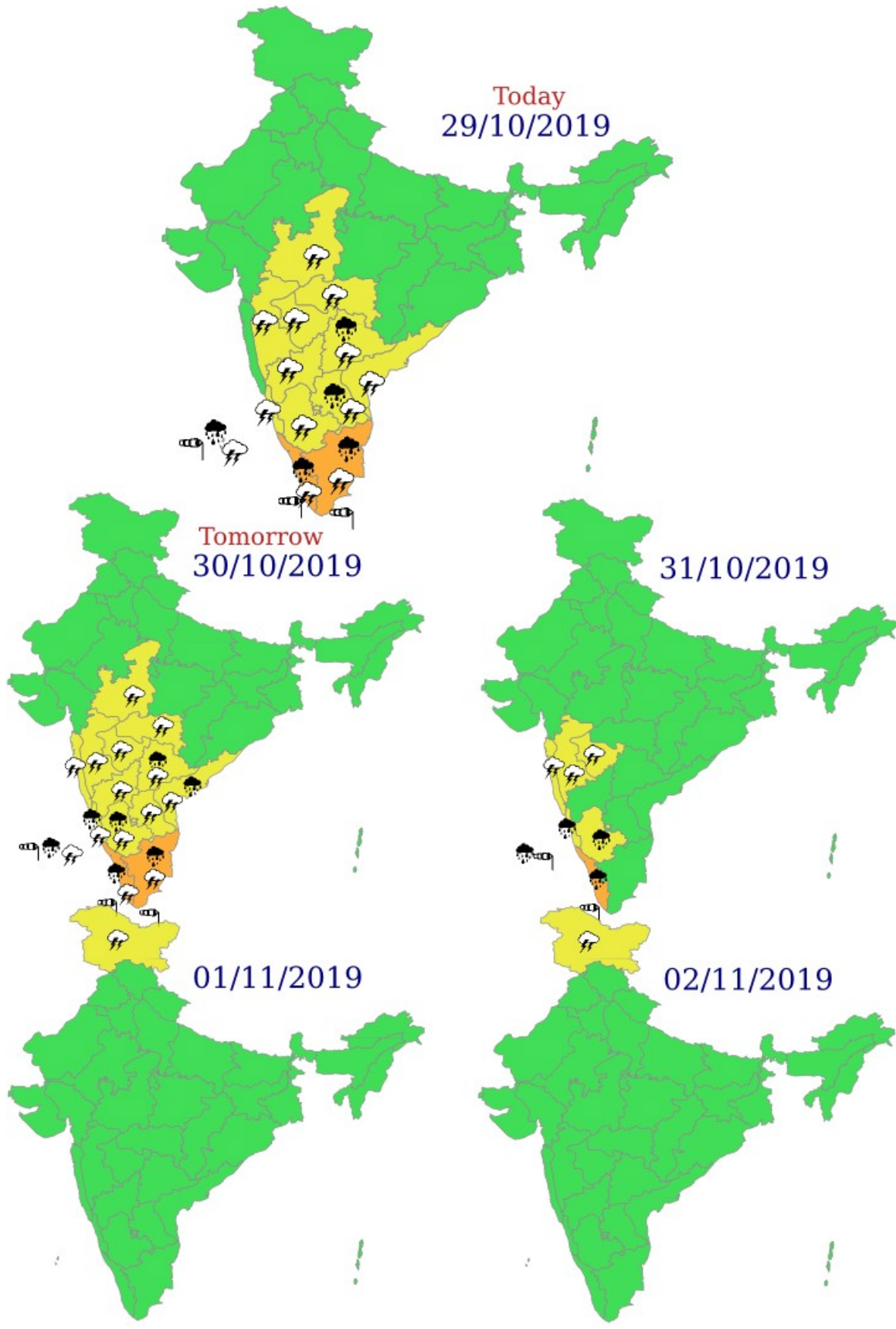
02 November (Day 5): ♦ Thunderstorm accompanied with lightning and hail likely at isolated places over Jammu & Kashmir.

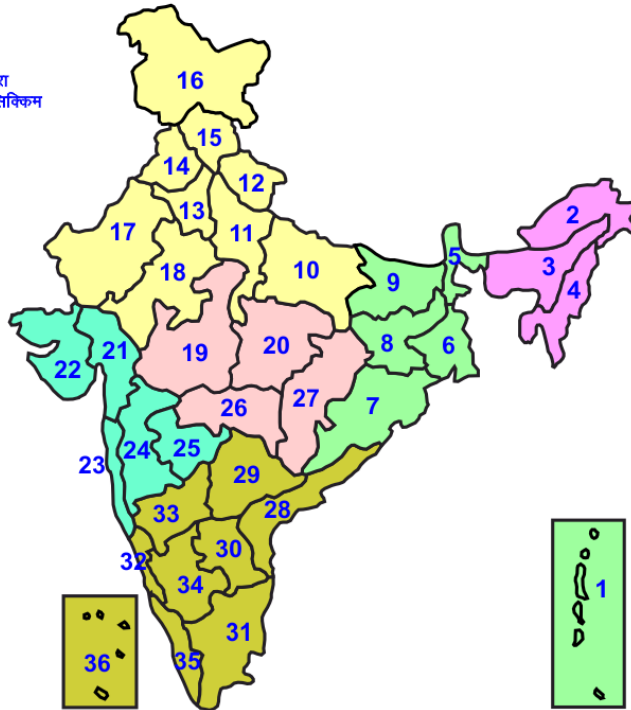
