

ORDER:

The Government in the letter first read above, among others, have approved the estimate of vacancies for the post of Deputy Superintendent of Police (Category.I) in the Tamil Nadu Police Service to be filled up by recruitment by transfer for the year 2022-2023, as '47'.

2. In his letters second read above, the Director General of Police has sent proposal for drawal of temporary panel of Inspectors of Police (Taluk) fit for appointment by recruitment by transfer as Deputy Superintendents of Police (Category.I) for the year 2022-2023.

3. The Government have carefully examined the proposal of the Director General of Police and have decided to draw the temporary panel of Inspectors of Police fit for appointment by recruitment by transfer as Deputy Superintendents of Police (Category.I) for the year 2022-2023 by

including 47 Inspectors of Police and also to relax rule 4(B) of the Special Rules for the Tamil Nadu Police Service relating to completion of 5 years of service in the post of Inspector of Police in favour of Thiru.A.Kanagathan (SL.No.8) and also to relax rule 4(G) of the Special Rules for the Tamil Nadu Police Service regarding the condition of completion of pre-promotion course of four weeks conducted by the Tamil Nadu Police Academy, Chennai in favour of the 41 Inspectors of Police (Taluk), since they have not completed the course on the crucial date i.e., 01.06.2022.

4. Accordingly, in exercise of the powers conferred by section 58 of the Tamil Nadu Government Servants (Conditions of Service) Act, 2016, the Governor of Tamil Nadu hereby relaxes rule 4(B) of the Special Rules for the Tamil Nadu Police Service in favour of Thiru.A.Kanagathan and also relaxes rule 4(G) of the Special Rules for the Tamil Nadu Police Service in favour of the 41 Inspectors of Police (Taluk) mentioned below at Sl.Nos.1,5,6,7,8,12,13,14,15,16,17,18,19,20,21,22,23,24,25,26,27,28, 29,30,31,32,33,34,35,36,37,38,39,40,41,42,43,44,45,46,47 and approve the temporary panel of Inspectors of Police fit for appointment by recruitment by transfer as Deputy Superintendents of Police (Category.I) for the year 2022-2023 by including the following 47 Inspectors of Police:-

The Government further order that the inclusion of Thiru.M.Suthesan (Sl.No.19), and Thiru.N.Thirupathi (Sl.No.21) are subject to the outcome of the W.P.(MD) No.14641/2019 and W.P.(MD) No.13212/2019 respectively filed by them challenging the recommendation of the State Human Rights Commission made against them and pending on the file of the Hon'ble Madurai Bench of Madras High Court, Madurai.
